Enhancing Quality and Safety

Adapted from high-risk industries such as aviation and nuclear power, RCA is one of the most widely used methods for identifying health system failures that contribute to patient safety incidents.¹

Medication administration errors are a major concern among medical professionals and patients. These errors can predispose patients to disability, huge losses, lawsuits, and deaths.

Developing effective solutions for these errors can be challenging. However, healthcare professionals can develop an effective system for reducing them by [nurs fpx 4030 assessment 3 picot questions](#) a series of behavioral change strategies. The Five As behavior change model can help them achieve their goals.

Keeping communication lines open encourages health care professionals to share ideas and feedback with each other.
